

What If I Sin?

Sometimes I will still sin, even though I am saved., but I must always remember that God still loves me now and forever! Once I got saved, I know I am always saved! (Romans 5:8) “But God commendeth (showed) His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”

YES! God has forgiven ALL your sins when you trusted Jesus as Saviour: past, present, and future. Read Psalm 103:12.

Sin is a serious thing that God hates. a clear conscious, when you sin, confess it to God...not to get saved again, but to restore fellowship (closeness) with Him. (1 John 1:9) “If we confess (admit and be sorry for) our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

It is great to be in fellowship with God, knowing you are doing what God wants and pleasing Him.

When you have sin your life, God will not hear your prayers (unless it is a prayer to confess our sin!). Read Psalm 66:18.

Fellowship is different than a relationship. Once a person is saved, he or she becomes God’s child. Nothing can ever take him or her out of God’s family. The saved person has a relationship with God (Read Galatians 4:5 & Romans 8:15.).

But What If...?

What If I Did Not Pray the Right Things?

Words are not nearly as important to God as what you believed in your heart.

Luke 23:42 tells that the thief that hung on a cross near Jesus before He died said, “remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom.” And, in the next verse, Jesus said, “...Verily I say unto thee, To day shalt thou be with me in paradise.” Their was no special five minute long, repeat after me prayer. The man simply knew he was a sinner and needed Jesus to save him from his sin.

The Holy Spirit, who is God, makes intercession...that means He prays in your behalf when you don't know all the words to say. Romans 8:26-27 “Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to the will of God.”

What if I don't Feel any different?

Regardless of what some people say, salvation is not a feeling. Some people cry to God to save them, others pray with a huge smile on their face, others show no emotion at all. Feelings change, but God and His Word, the Bible never change!

The Holy Spirit lives inside of you the minute you get saved. He is the one who convicts you when you do wrong and who comforts you when you are sad. Romans 8:16 “The Spirit itself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:”

God gave you the Bible so you can know, based on what He has told you where you will spend eternity.

1 John 5:13 “These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.”

John 8:32, “And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.”

Romans 8:15, “For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.”

Those who are saved are completely FREE from the bondage of sin forever! If you have accepted Jesus, you can KNOW that your sins are forgiven and you are adopted by Him!

What If God Doesn't Want Me As His Child Anymore?

When you get saved, God the Father adopts you into the family of God. God promises in the Bible that He holds the believer in His hand and nothing can take Him out. John 10:28-30 “And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one.” Claim that promise for yourself and never forget it!

What If God Thought I Was Too Bad To Save In The First Place?

Yes, you are a sinner by nature, and God hates sin. However, God loves the sinner. If God was willing to save Saul (Acts 9), a man who did horrible things to believers and even supported killing them, caused havoc in the church, and hated the things of God, but God still loved and accepted him as His child when he repented, surely God will accept you. Romans 5:8 “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.” Claim that promise!

THINK ABOUT IT!

Doubting whether or not you are saved after you know that there was a sure time when you trusted Him as Savior is to call God a liar. Titus 1:2 “In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;”
