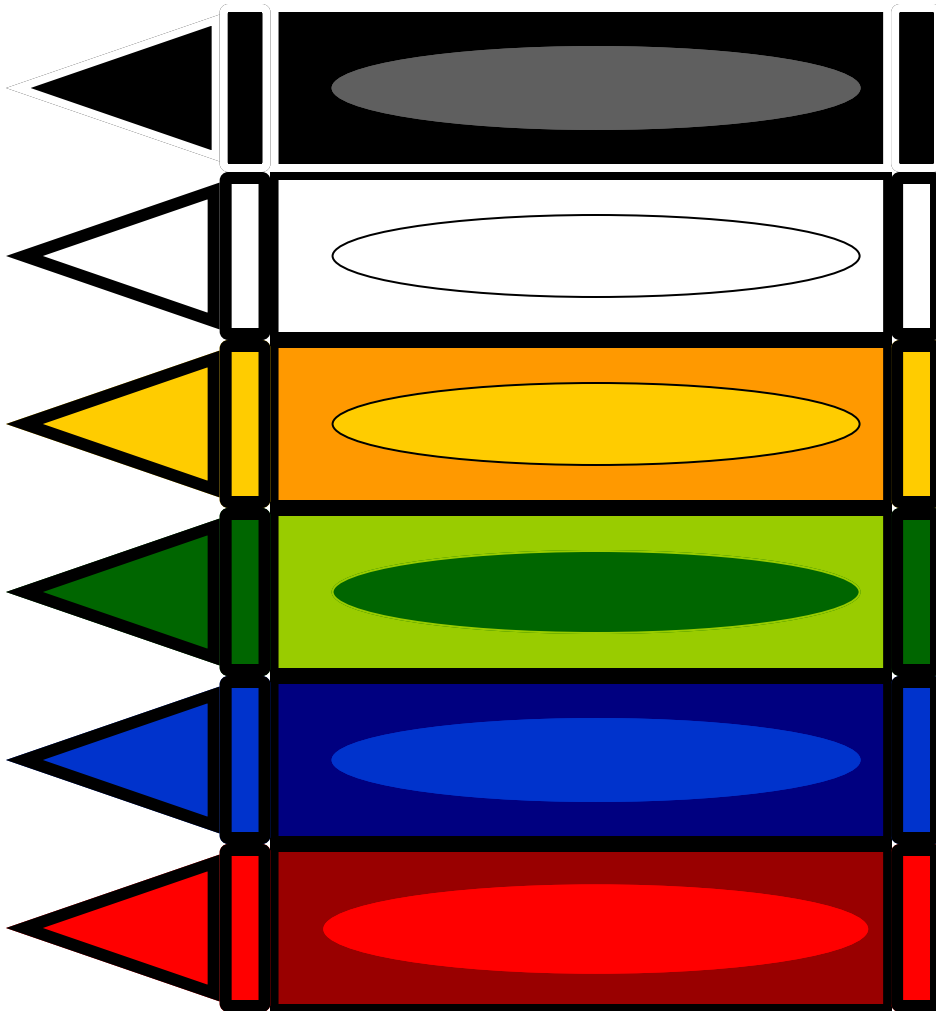


The Crayon Box



Every student should get a brightly colored envelope with their name on it.

Option 1-Laminate the paper crayons. Every time a student breaks a rule, he or she loses one crayon. For a repeated offence, take away two crayons the second time, three for the third, etc.

Make appropriate consequences, depending on your classes needs...

Here are examples:

If a student loses

1-2 crayons-warning

3-4-time outs/loss of privileges

5-6-contact parents

Option 2-Use real, jumbo size crayon boxes (you can buy a box with 4-8 jumbo crayons at most dollar stores!)

If doing option 1, Fold on center line. Wrap colored tape around the two short sides. Leave the unfolded long side open. The “name” goes on the front.
