Where to Look In the Bible

If I have failed or am afraid of failing:

Psalms 56:3, Proverbs 22:3, 24:16, and
Philippians 1:6, 4:13

**I need to forgive somebody, but am
having a hard time:** Proverbs 21:13,
Matthew 6:14-15, 7:1-5, Ephesians 4:32,
and Colossians 3:13

My friends are trying to get me to sin.

Proverbs 4:14-15, Matthew 26:41, 1
Corinthians 10:13, Ephesians 6:10-18, II
Peter 1:13-18, Daniel 1:8. 2 Tim. 2:5;

I Can Talk to God Each Day!

**Did you know that praying is just
talking to God? Friends get to know each
other better by talking and spending
time with each other. God wants to be
your friend, and to hear from you every
day. You can talk to God anytime,
anywhere, and about anything.**

How do I pray? (Read Matthew 6:9-13.

This is just an example.)

- 1. Acknowledge who you are talking to.**
- 2. Start with confessing any known sin to God.**
- 3. Thank God for specific things He has done or given.**
- 4. Pray (ask) for other's needs.**
- 5. Pray for your own needs.**
- 6. End the prayer in Jesus' name.**
