

## Sunday School Lesson 9 (Primarys)

Unit Theme: Esther—Obedience to God

Title: The Golden Sceptre

Scripture: Esther 5:1-8

Lesson Objective: The child will learn to be brave enough to trust God will help them do things that are scary to do.

Materials needed: Golden sceptre for review game.

1. Learn Proverbs 3:5-6
2. Sing “Trust and Obey”
3. Begin lesson with prayer
4. Play gold sceptre review game after the lesson.

Introduction: Ask a few review questions and go straight into the story.

Progression of events outline:

1. Esther appears before the King on his throne.
2. The King holds out the sceptre and Esther touches it.
3. The King asks Esther what her request is, even to half the kingdom.
4. Esther asks the King and Haman to come to a banquet.
5. The King and Haman come to the banquet.
6. At the banquet, the King again asks Esther what her request is.
7. Esther replies by inviting the King and Haman to another banquet on the next day.

Conclusion:

Queen Esther is a good example that you can learn from. She was brave enough to come before the King even though she could have faced death had not she obtained his favor. She loved her people enough to risk her own life for them. Are you willing to give yourself for Christ and the people all around you that need the salvation you have to share with them? All you have to do is trust the Lord to be with you and remember that He will never ask you to do something that is too hard for you to do in His power.
