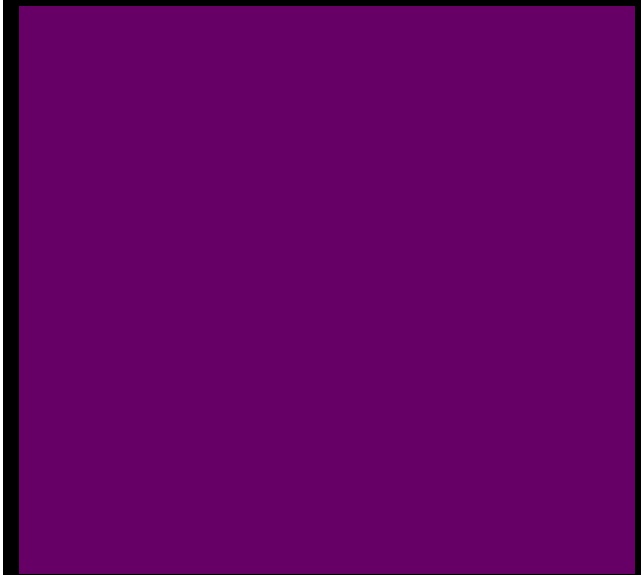
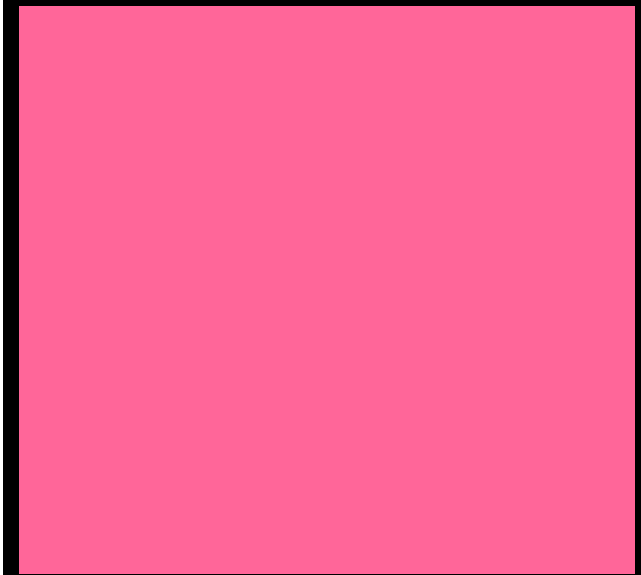
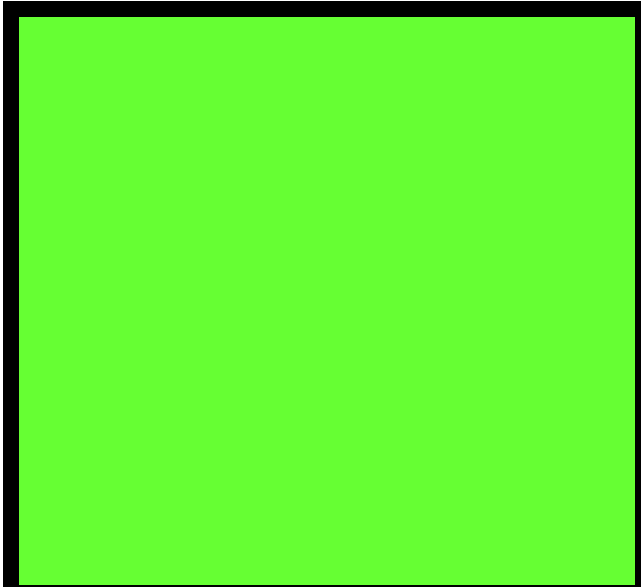
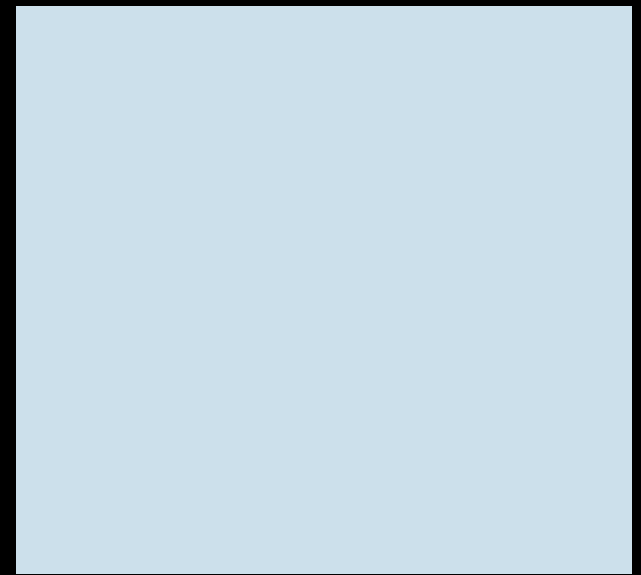
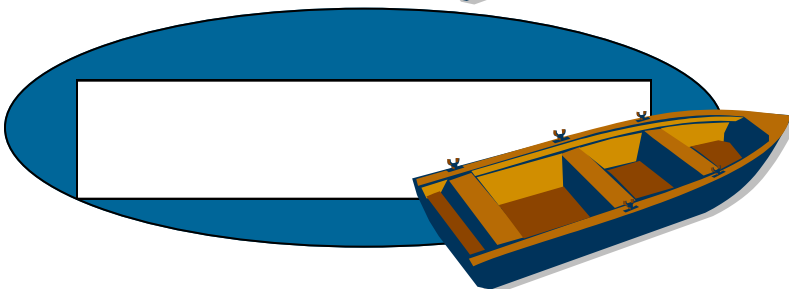
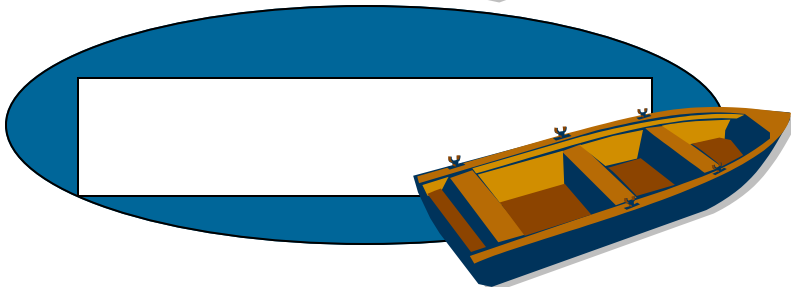
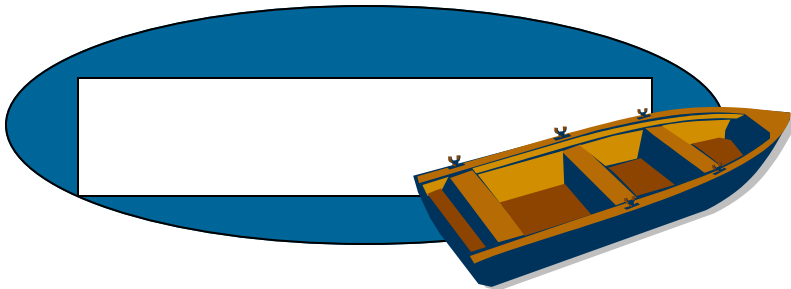
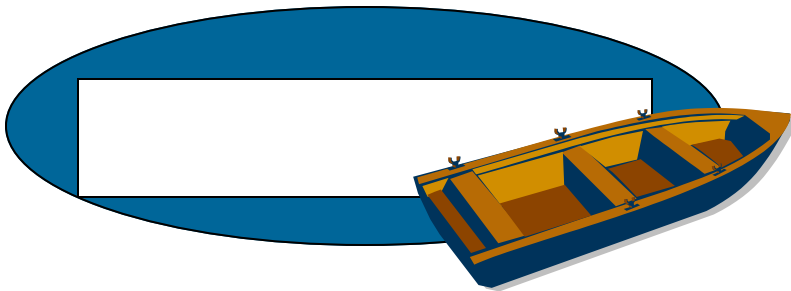
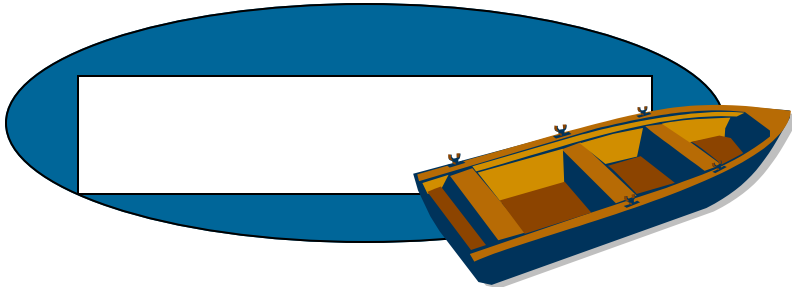
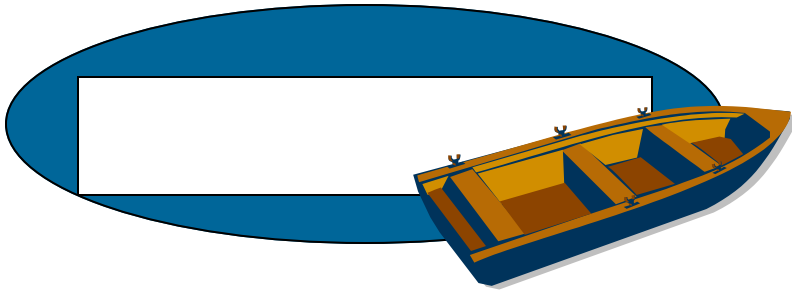


Treasure Hunt!!!

The printable wall board game file contains just multicolored squares (6 per page). Print as many as you want and cut them out (for a big wall, you may want to use full pieces of construction paper for each game square). Attach the squares to the wall in stripes of three, connecting the stripes to make a long path. Designate a starting square. Have one game piece for each student with their name on it. Each time a child does a certain achievement (such as attendance, memory verse, bringing a friend, etc), let them move their piece. Laminate pieces for durability. The square with a gem is so students can earn an incentive (small prize, class party or event, etc.) for reaching one. Space these evenly. You could choose let them earn small incentives every few squares or have a big incentive for reaching the end of the wall game before a designated time.
